3. If the specified recipient fails to appear or arrives late, they agree to reimburse the company for the duration the vehicle stays in the ship's garage.
4. There are no valuables or money inside the vehicle for which any compensation can be requested.
5. The sender is responsible for loading the vehicle on board while the recipient is responsible for unloading it. For any damage suffered by the vehicle due to incorrect handling of the vehicle by the sender or the recipient, the carrier bears no responsibility.
6. In case the vehicle cannot be moved due to damage, the carrier is responsible for undertaking the unloading of the vehicle at his own expense.
7. The recipient will promptly notify the ship's First Officer of any damage they believe may have occurred to the vehicle while it was parked in the ship's garage. After the delivery of the vehicle to the recipient, the company does not recognize any damage statement.
8. The carrier bears no responsibility for any issues that might occur during the vehicle's unloading, subject to control of the port authority.
9. It undertakes to compensate the carrier for any claims and expenses it may be required to pay for compensation, penalties or fines the carrier may be obligated to cover, as imposed by port, customs, or other authorities regarding the vehicle.
10. The vehicle does not carry dangerous, flammable loads or illegal cargo.
